Last time I wrote was just before Thanksgiving & everything was fine. Then, just 2 days later, on that Saturday, I felt sore, especially my chest. This was not uncommon so I thought nothing of it at the time. The next day I was talking to my family and it seemed like everyone was sick. They were odd symptoms like weird body aches & my mother had an ear ache. So, individually we didn't think much. But we soon realized it was weird we all felt sick. There were 9 people in my house at the time, 5 decided to go & get tested on that Monday. On Tuesday all their (COVID) tests came back positive. We then knew we all had it. The doctors told us to wait 10 days after our 1st symptoms to go out because you are no longer contagious after 10 days. All of our symptoms varied. My father was the worst, he was unable to stand on his own & got very light headed. He also had a bad cough & other things. My mother just had her ear & back aches. My brother & brother-in-law had a headache for about a day, my friend that was here for a bit had a fever of around 103 for 2 days, and I had a constant headache for 7 days. Later on my ~~head~~ head hurt to the point it hurt to breathe. Another

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Weird thing is that my lungs tickled. It was the weirdest feeling. It felt like getting sat on while being tickled with a rough feather. My sister & her boyfriend were ~~supposed~~ supposed to move out of the house the day the results got back. Luckily their landlord still let them move in. My Father had to go to the ER once for breathing, but other than that the experience overall wasn't terrifying. Obviously everyone's experience is different. I'm just lucky my family is pretty active & in good health!
