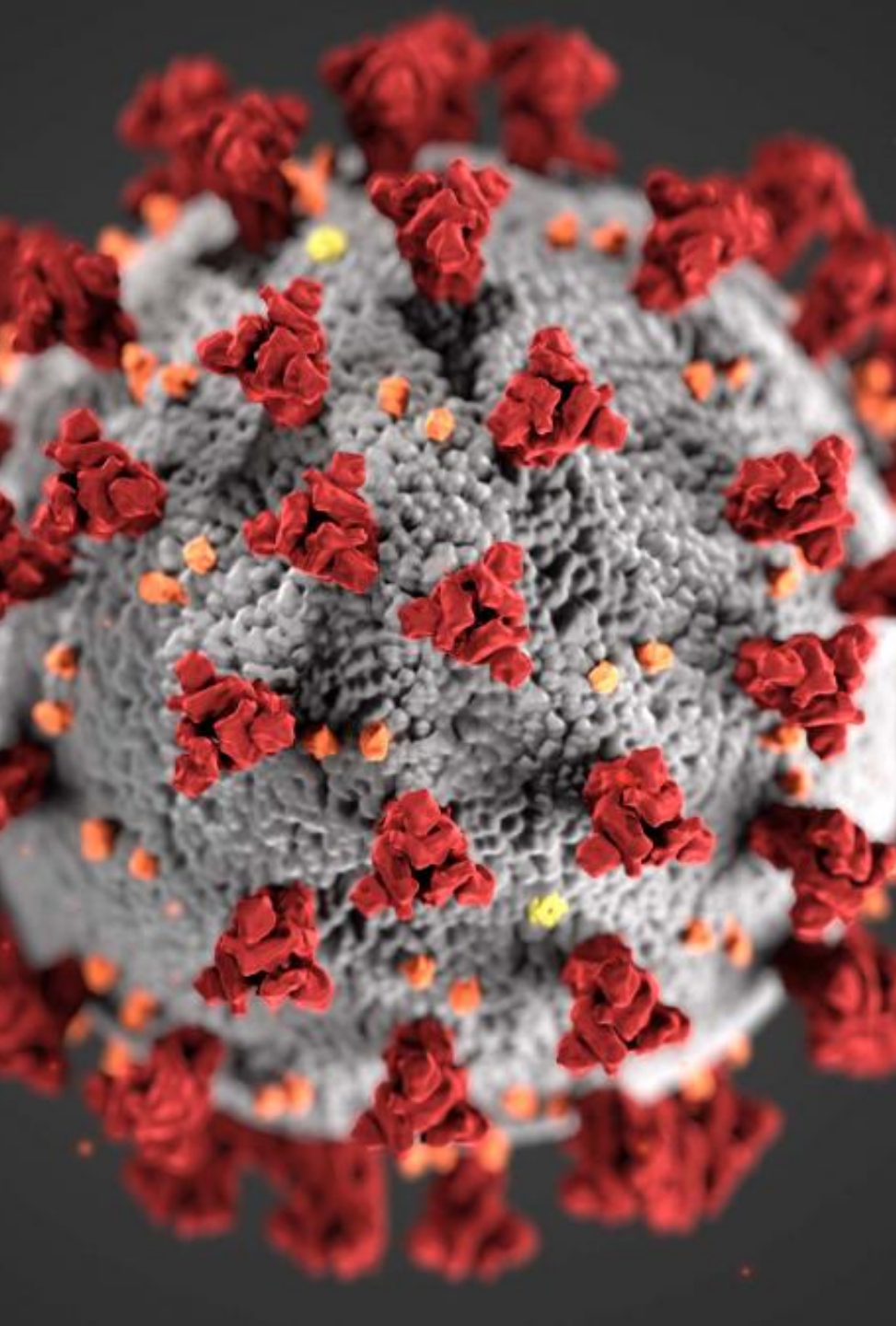




# Covid-19 Primary Source

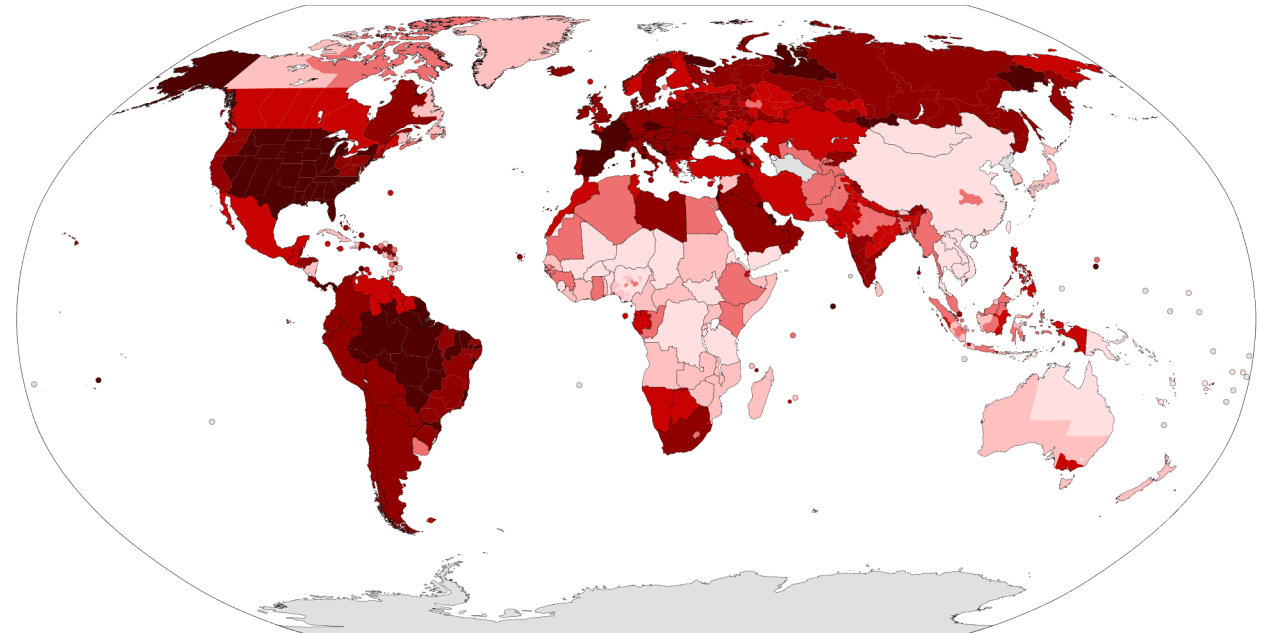
# COVID-19
