INTRODUCTION

FANFARE AND ENTRANCE (continue reading)

"The Blugold Band begins our gridiron show with a brilliant fanfare and march across the field to the music of 'Marching Along Together'."

GOAL POST FORMATION (Read after band shouts 'HI' and bells begin interlude)

*Goal posts are essential equipment in football, so the band makes this symbol of the game and plays the well-known march, 'Down the Field'."*

FOOTBALL FORMATION (Read during bells interlude)

"Goal posts call for a football. Here is a big one for our favorite gridiron heroes."

TROPHY FORMATION (Read during bells interlude)

"The players in the band are enthusiastic boosters of their team. They present the Blugolds now with a Paul Bunyan size trophy and play 'Our Boys Will Shine Tonight'."

BLOCK E FORMATION (Read during bells interlude)

"For the returning alumni, the band forms its traditional 'E' and plays our 'Alma Mater'."

"Let's all sing!" (Add, after E forms and just before music starts)

CROWN FORMATION (Read during bells interlude)

"The climax of tonight's pageantry is the presentation of the Homecoming Queen and her court. With the band in a crown formation, we now introduce the queen and her court."

EXIT (Read as the band leaves the field)

"As drum major Glenn Miller leads the Marching Blugolds off the field LET'S GIVE THE BAND A BIG HAND."
