Date: December 3rd, 2020

I also had to call the store today, because it turns out that 6 people my girlfriend and I were around on Saturday, throughout the day, tested positive for Covid-19. Also, my parents are getting sick, so that mean eventually I'll probably get it too. Mom and I are going to get tested on Saturday morning since no one around has anything available on Friday. I'm not scared of it at all, just sucks because I really need money and I work days now instead of nights like before, so I work with a bunch of really nice older ladies. Hopefully, I didn't give it to any of them.

Date: December 8th, 2020

Test results came back, my mother tested positive with Covid. Surprisingly, even with a few symptoms, I tested negative so hopefully none of the older ladies ended up getting sick. I still have to quarantine for a while since I live with my mom and have no where else I could live so I'm stuck with the potential of getting it but I think I'll be alright. I think I would have gotten it already if I were going to get it.

As of Today, December 11, 2020, I am still quarantined since it's basically the same length as if you had Covid just because I live in the same house that two people have it. But I'm alright though, money is a little tight because I think we'll manage. My girlfriend tested negative as well so that's good. Now, it's just dealing with everything that's coming from work since they think it's all fake because they don't have many people working currently but also the possibility that I could still get it since two people here have it. I've been using Lysol in my room every other day or so to make sure that no germs can linger around so I think I'll manage.
