At 400 members the Blugold Marching Band (BMB) is the largest and one of the most active marching bands in the Midwest. The BMB season includes Blugold home football games, contest exhibitions, and other selected performances. Every year the BMB is seen by thousands of high school band students at multiple contest exhibitions around the Midwest. The BMB has performed 12 times at Youth in Music (Minneapolis) and 4 times as the guest exhibition band for Bands of America (BOA) in St Louis and Indianapolis. BMB is a regular at Music Along the Chippewa and has performed many times at other shows in Chicago, Milwaukee, and the Twin Cities.

Since 2008 the BMB has made 6 international tours to 12 foreign countries and has performed in venues including the Roman Colosseum, St. Peter's Square, the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, the Greek Parliament in Athens, and the Marina in Singapore. From Jerusalem to Barcelona; Bali to Istanbul; Paris to Thailand, London to Tokyo, BMB members have truly traveled the world. A 7th international performance tour, to Australia and New Zealand will take place next year.

BMB membership is open to UW-Eau Claire students of any major and represents virtually every department on campus. While music majors are the largest single group in the BMB, 70% of the band members are not music majors.
