ABOUT THE GUEST ARTIST

Herbert Blayman was solo clarinetist with New York City's Metropolitan Opera Orchestra for 31 years, and is a former member of the Goldman Band and the Utah Symphony.

Blayman received a scholarship to and graduated from the Julliard School of Music. He taught at the Manhattan School of Music for 18 years, served as artist-teacher at Trenton State College for 25 years, and served on the faculty of the National Music Camp at Interlochen, Michigan.

He continues to teach privately, perform recitals and conduct clinics throughout the country. He is president of H. S. Blayman, Inc., which manufactures supporting stands for musical instruments and mouth-pieces for the clarinet.
