THE U.W.E.C. JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Since 1965 the University jazz program has steadily grown in quality, reputation and size. We now have three jazz ensembles, an organized combo in each band and jazz improvisation lessons. To date the ensembles' credits include:

Performance of Jazz Ensemble and Brass Choir at the Wisconsin State Music Convention, Madison, January 1970;

Winner, Elmhurst Midwest Jazz Festival, March 1971;

Performance by invitation, National Jazz Festival, University of Illinois, sponsored by the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, May 1971;

By tape audition, chosen to perform at the National Music Educators National Conference Convention in Atlanta, Georgia, March 1972.

STUDENT COMPOSERS AND ARRANGERS

Chris De Rose is a senior at Horlick High School in Racine, Wisconsin. She plays guitar in the school's stage band under the direction of band director, Ken Resheske.

Randy Wanless, a scholarship student from Viola, is a music education major. He is studying saxophone, clarinet and composition and plays 1st Saxophone in Jazz Ensemble I and the Symphony Band.
