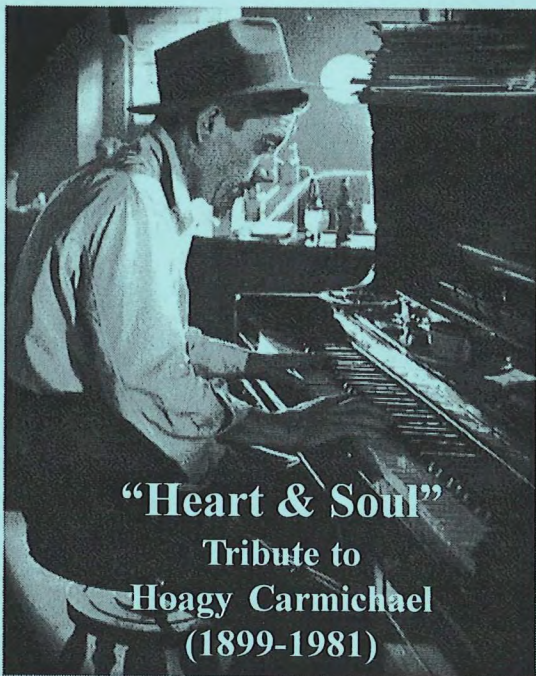

UW-Eau Claire Jazz Ensemble I

The University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Jazz I Ensemble is recognized as one of the premiere jazz ensembles in the United States. The ensemble has received the Down Beat Award for best college jazz ensemble five times in the last eight years. The ensemble has recorded eleven CDs to date. All CDs have come under critical acclaim. "Jazz in Clear Water- Brilliant Corners," "Jazz in Clear Water-Hoe Down," and "Jazz in Clear Water-Things to Come," "Jazz in Clear Water-Vernal Fields," and "Jazz in Clear Water-Yes & No" received the prestigious Down Beat Award for Best College Big Band. Numerous students have also received Down Beat Awards. The 1998 release of "Jazz in Clear Water-Harpoon" and the 2001 release of "Jazz in Clear Water-Things to Come" were nominated for a Grammy.

The group has performed internationally in Europe and the Pacific Rim. While performing in China, Jazz Ensemble I was recognized as the first jazz ensemble to tour the country since its opening to the western world.

In 2003-2004 Jazz Ensemble I was the featured group at both the International Midwest Clinic in Chicago and the National MENC Conference in Minneapolis.
