

BILL BERRY

It is a privilege for us to present Mr. Bill Berry as guest soloist with the UW-Eau Claire Jazz Ensemble I for this evening's concert. A former member of the Woody Herman, Maynard Ferguson, and Duke Ellington Orchestras, and a member of the Merv Griffin Show band for over 11 years, cornetist Bill Berry has earned a reputation as one of the finest of all mainstream jazz soloists. He has received consistent critical and popular acclaim for his albums for Concord Jazz, M&K, and Beez Records, and his L.A.-based big band is universally regarded as the best on the West Coast. Bill is active as a touring soloist - he recently toured Japan with Benny Carter - and as a Los Angeles studio musician.

This concert marks the end of a three-day tour for Bill and the Ensemble, during which time they performed five concerts and four clinics at schools in Western Wisconsin and Eastern Minnesota. We are grateful to the Yamaha Musical Instrument Company for its support in bringing Bill Berry to Wisconsin. Bill plays Yamaha instruments exclusively.
