I took this video the day before I received my placement, this past Wednesday. I was able to take a long walk through all of Central Park and do a lot of reflection. This musician at the Central Park Terrace lifted my heart.

I had my first day yesterday but it was mostly orientation. Today I'll be in the ICU. All the patients here are Covid-19+.

The people here have seen and been through a lot. But there are glimpses of hope, the tent outside the hospital yesterday that was being used as a back up ER bay was closed due to not needing it. They told us this was the first day that they haven't needed it.

.

All inpatient units are makeshift ICUs now. My crew is full of knowledgeable men and women with ICU experience here to help, both the patients and the nurses. We are being supplied the PPE we need.



I know I'm overdue for an update...

First of all - thank you to EVERYONE who has checked in on me, shared loving and supportive sentiments, and sent needed items and food/coffee money - ALL have been so appreciated and I promise to try to repay your kindnesses when I can.

I only know what I see and do directly so I can't speak to the situation in NYC as a whole, and even within my hospital the situation is different from unit to unit. The supplies I use for protection and the care I can provide is unique to just this one small place among the big picture of things. And to be honest I was MUCH more aware of the big picture before I came, when I could keep myself up to date with the data and news. Since I've been working 14h a day (including the bus commute) and sleeping 6.5-7h a night with time for NOTHING else, I literately have to FaceTime my family while I scarf down food so I can try to get to bed as soon possible. I'm often the one ironically asking my husband, "so what's going on in NY? What're the numbers like here?"

THIS hospital and here are some things I know to be true.

- √ There are so many deaths happening
- √ Yes, we have a freezer truck for the deceased, two in fact
- ✓ When someone gets extubated (breathing tube removed because they can breathe on their own again) they play Fight Song over the hospital-wide PA system, I've heard it at least once every day. Everyone stops what they're doing and claps or cheers, even if it's not on their unit or their patient. I can't help but tear up every time
- ✓ When someone leaves the hospital because they recovered, they play New York, New York. I've only heard it once.
- √ The hospital I'm in is almost entirely run and staffed by our organization's relief nurses
- √ The Army is also here helping
- ✓ The nurses I work with who are from here are kind, helpful, and appreciative- they always say thank you for coming
- ✓ Every day there are some "original" staff I work with who have either been very sick themselves or have taken care of colleagues as

- ✓ Every day there are some "original" staff I work with who have either been very sick themselves or have taken care of colleagues as patients here who have been critically ill
- ✓ Families cannot be with their loved ones who are sick, unless they're actively dying and then it's only 2 and for only a few minutes and they have to wear an N95 mask
- √ I hear vent/ cardiac monitor alarms in my sleep
- ✓ Supplies run low, it's not just ventilators to be worried about, it's things we need to provide adequate care, other things that are imperative to save people
- ✓ The healthcare system in this country is so broken, and this novel virus brought it to its knees here in NYC
- ✓ So far I've gotten a new N95 each day from the hospital. Just a few days before my wave came to help, they were rationed to 5-7 days. The nurses here held a walkout and they listened.
- √ The rule my organization lives by is "no mask, no nurse"
- ✓ Yesterday upon our arrival to work our shift

- ✓ Yesterday upon our arrival to work our shift they told us there were no masks, but then an hour later they brought us some... until then we just waited. Part of me wanted to get sent back to the hotel for the day to sleep and rest, but I also felt horrible for the nurses and patients that had to wait on me; I came here for them.
- ✓ My thumb is really sore and calloused from popping the top off of so many medication vials
- ✓ A patient I cared for recently had been on the vent so long they put in a tracheotomy. When he came back from surgery he had ulcers on his face from the breathing tube securing device and the proning therapy he had received. The RT I worked with said in his Belarus accent, "this is how we will know who was sick when we are walking down the streets in the future. By the scars on their faces." My first thought was, I hope they are walking down the street someday...
