E. C. FORMATION

"For all the Blugold fans the band now forms the letters E. C. and plays the college Alma Mater. Let's all sing it!"

V-FORMATION

"To spur their team on to victory, the band forms a big "V" and Blays "Happy Days are Here Again."

BLOCK FORMATION (R.F. Greeting)

"The band now greets the visiting fans from River Falls by playing 'Hi Neighbor'."

CROWN FORMATION

"The presentation of the Homecoming Queen and her court is the highlight of tonight's pageantry. So the band now forms a coronation crown and plays, 'I'll! See You in My Dreams' while the queen and her court are introduced."

EXIT (Read as the band leaves the field)

"Drum major Chuck Mehls now leads the Marching Blugolds off the Field."
