## GOOD LUCK FORMATION (Read during bell theme)

## STEVENS POINT SALUTE (Read during bell theme)

"Now the band plays a stirring march and forms a large letter  $\underline{S}$  to salute the host college and its team."

# EAU CLAIRE SALUTE (Read after S changes)

"The letter S is transformed next into a large E for the Blugold team and the Eau Claire fans. The band plays their college "Alma Mater" and invites its fans to join in the singing."
