## About the Blugold Marching Band

In the past few years the **Blugold Marching Band** has become one of the largest and most active marching bands in the upper Midwest. Each season the performance calendar includes Blugold home football games, three contest exhibitions, and several other selected performances. Recent performances have included two Green Bay Packers half-time shows, stage shows in four countries, plus several regional trips. In '07-'08 the BMB performed in eight cities and four countries for combined audiences of 150,000+. The season concluded with special performances at the New Year's Day Papal Blessing in St. Peter's Square, Vatican City and stage shows in Florence, Italy and Athens, Greece. The '09-'10 season includes trips to Chicago, Minneapolis, and a European tour to Paris (FR), London (UK), and Venice (IT).

Membership is open to students of any major and represents virtually every department on campus. While music is still the most populous major in the band 65% of the members come from outside the music department. 270 band members are selected from applications accepted online from February 15th until all positions are filled. **Dr. Randal C. Dickerson** is an Associate Professor of Music Education at the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire where he directs the Blugold Marching Band (BMB) and the University Band, teaches courses in Music Education, and supervises student teachers. Since his arrival at UW-Eau Claire in 2000 the BMB has increased from 60 members to more than 270 members and has taken its place alongside the other outstanding ensembles in the Dept. of Music & Theatre Arts. Dickerson is an active adjudicator and consultant for concert and marching bands throughout the United States, Bermuda, Europe, and the Caribbean. He is also a prolific drill writer and arranger of marching band music.

Before coming to UW-Eau Claire Dickerson spent six years as Asst. Dean for Academic Affairs at the University of Illinois. During his seven years as a high school band director in Mississippi and Washington, Dickerson's ensembles consistently received superior ratings and amassed awards from many festivals in the US and Canada.

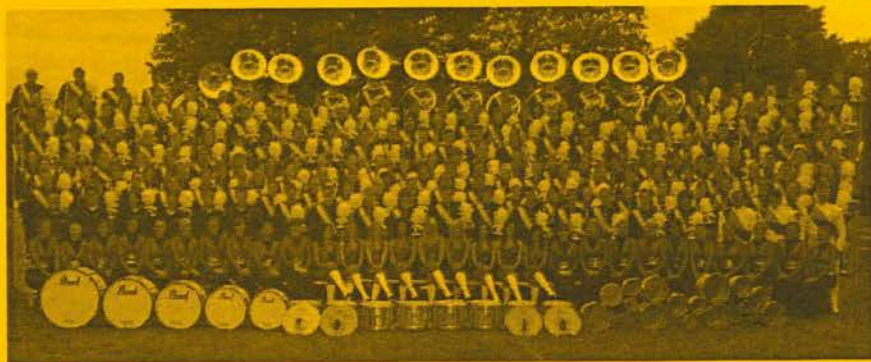
