UWEC Jazz Ensemble I

The University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Jazz Studies Area has a long tradition of outstanding jazz education which has been affirmed by international and state awards and distinctions. In the past four years Jazz Ensemble I has been selected to perform twice for the Wisconsin Music Educators Conference.

Selected last year as an outstanding ensemble to perform for the internationally acclaimed Montreux Jazz Festival in Montreux, Switzerland, Jazz Ensemble I also was the only Jazz ensemble selected to perform at the Graz American Music Festival held in Graz, Austria. Recognition of the band's performances were recorded in an article about the Montreux Jazz Festival in the November/December issue of the BDGuide.

Jazz Ensemble I is the host band for the UW-Eau Claire Jazz Festival which is one of the nation's largest, now in its 24th year. Under their director, Robert Baca, the ensemble has performed with Rufus Reid, Dominic Spera, Rob McConnell, James Williams, Billy Pierce, Allen Vizutti, Rick Margitza, John Von Ohlen, Matt Harris, Brian Torff and Bill Evans.

The UW-Eau Claire Jazz Studies Area currently maintains five large jazz ensembles, a vocal jazz ensemble and nine combos. The instrumental and vocal groups frequently perform clinics and concerts throughout the states of Wisconsin and Minnesota. ROBERT BACA, THE DIRECTOR

Mr. Baca's versatility as a composite trumpet player and his contributions to music teaching have gained him wide recognition in jazz and classical areas of the performing arts. He received a B.M.E., M.M., and is currently completing a D.M. in performance from Indiana University. He has taught privately in public school systems for over 15 years and has worked as a band director in the Lockport, Illinois public schools.

His professional background includes touring as a member of the Frank Sinatra Orchestra, the Buddy Rich Big Band, Mel Torme, Tony Bennett, and Charles Aznavour and is currently a member of the Andy Williams and Pia Zadora Orchestras. He has performed with the Milwaukee Symphony and has done prolific work as principal trumpet and soloist with various orchestras including the Grand Teton Festival Seminar Orchestra. Mr Baca is also active in studio recording and location contract work in New York City, Indianapolis, Cincinnati, Minneapolis and Chicago. During Christmas Break he will be on tour with the Andy Williams Christmas Show, Frank Sinatra and Pia Zadora.

He is very active as an international performer and solist/clinician for the Selmer Bach Corporation and has served as guest lecturer throughout the United States and Canada.
