#### About the Pacesetters. . .

The Air Force Band of the Midwest's jazz ensemble, the Pacesetters, features the big band sound with 18 musicians who can please audiences of all types. Stationed at Chanute Air Force Base in east-central Illinois, the group performs before vast audiences throughout the midwestern United States.

The band, which features a vocalist, performs the music of Glenn Miller and Count Basie, as well as the more contemporary sounds of Buddy Rich, Woody Herman and Toshiko Akiyoshi. Original compositions and arrangements are also contributed by a staff arranger as well as by Pacesetters. Accomplished jazz soloists in every section have helped to establish this band as one of the finest jazz ensembles in the United States today.

During the school year the Pacesetters perform at high schools, colleges, jazz festivals and music conventions. The summer months bring the group to state fairs, festivals and many other community celebrations. The band has also performed with such jazz artists as Maynard Ferguson, Dizzy Gillespie, Roger Pemberton and Mike Metheny.
