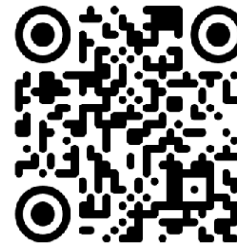

She has also served as a baritone technician at the Colts Drum and Bugle Corps since 2020. Kara became the brass arranger for the Minnesota Brass Drum and Bugle Corps in 2025. She has held additional staff positions at the Blue Stars Drum and Bugle corps for the 2018 and 2019 seasons. Kara continues to engage with high schools by being active in writing drill, choreography, arranging, and clinicing for numerous high schools and colleges throughout the country.



Dr. Phillip A. Ostrander is Professor of Trombone and Bands at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire where he conducts the Symphony Band, teaches private trombone, and trombone ensemble. Dr. Ostrander completed his doctoral studies at the Eastman School of Music. Dr. Ostrander received master's degrees in both trombone and wind conducting from the New England Conservatory, as well as a bachelor's and Performer's Certificate from Eastman. Prior to working at UW Eau Claire, he taught at SUNY Geneseo and Bethany College in Kansas.

He has performed with the Minnesota Orchestra, the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, the Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra, the Rochester Philharmonic, the Kansas City Symphony, the Buffalo Philharmonic, and the popular chamber groups Rhythm and Brass and the Burning River Brass Ensemble. Currently, he is Principal Trombone of the Minnesota Opera Orchestra. He performs on Broadway shows in Minneapolis - Hennepin Avenue Theatre District, recently on Wicked and Some Like It Hot. An accomplished jazz trombonist, Dr. Ostrander has collaborated with jazz artists Maria Schneider, Jim McNeely, Jimmy Heath, Claudio Roditi and Rich Beirach. He teaches jazz and created the Trombone Workshop at the Shell Lake Arts Camp in northern Wisconsin. He has recorded on Sony Classical with the Eastman Wind Ensemble and Naxos with the IRIS Orchestra. Dr. Ostrander is a clinician for the Conn-Selmer Musical Instrument Company.

The Donald Hunsberger Wind Library are available through Warner Brothers Publications. A new orchestration of Healy Willan's *Royce Hall Suite* and Imogen Holst's *The Unfortunate Traveler* is currently under consideration for publication. He collaborated with Morton Gould on the completion of the *American Ballads* for band and has made editions of Gould's *American Patrol* and Howard Hanson's *Pan and the Priest* for chamber winds and piano. Current projects include work on historical editions of music by Ralph Vaughan Williams. He has authored several articles that have appeared in *WASBE World*, *The Instrumentalist*, *Wind Works*, *BD Guide*, and the *Journal of Band Research*.

His professional affiliations include the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (Past President), College Band Directors National Association, and the National Association for Music Education. Mr. Ripley has appeared as guest clinician and conductor throughout the United States, Canada, and Japan.



Dr. Kara Metzger, originally from Waukesha Wisconsin, is currently serving as the Director of Athletics Bands at UW- Eau Claire. A pinnacle role within this position is to direct the 400+ member, Blugold Marching Band. She also directs the University Band, Varsity Band, and teaches a course in marching band procedures.

Prior to her time at UWEC, she served as the Director of Bands at Central Methodist University in Fayette, MO, teaching marching, concert, and jazz band as well as applied trombone and music education courses. She has earned a bachelor's in music education and a certificate in adaptive music from the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire. Kara earned graduate degrees from the University of Minnesota Duluth (MM-Music Education) and the University of Iowa (DMA-Wind Conducting). Whilst earning her graduate degrees, Kara was a teaching assistant within both schools' band departments. Throughout her time at the University of Iowa, Kara also served as Director of Symphonic Band at Grinnell College in Grinnell, IA. Prior to her graduate work, Kara was the director of bands at Whitman Middle School and associate director of bands at West High School in Wauwatosa, WI.

Since 2016, Kara has been working at the Colt Cadets Drum and

Dr. Stewart presently serves as a member of the board for the Wisconsin Concert Band Association and is the state chair for the National Band Association. His professional affiliations include College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Education, Wisconsin Music Educators Association, the National Band Association, the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Wind Ensembles, and Pi Kappa Lambda.



Dr. James C. Ripley is Professor of Music, and Director of Instrumental Music Activities at Carthage College. From 2001-20011, while teaching at Carthage, he was also Music Director and Principal Conductor of the Kurashiki Sukuyo University Wind Philharmony in Japan. At Carthage, Dr. Ripley conducts the Wind Orchestra, Concert Band and the chamber winds group AMATI. He also teaches classes in conducting, teaching methods

and psychoacoustics. Prior to his appointment at Carthage, Dr. Ripley served as Assistant Professor of Conducting and Ensembles at the Eastman School of Music, where he was the Associate Conductor of the Eastman Wind Ensemble and Wind Orchestra, and conductor of the Symphonic Wind Ensemble at the River Campus of the University of Rochester. In 2012, Dr. Ripley received the Carlo A. Sperati Award from Luther College for outstanding service in the field of instrumental music.

Dr. Ripley received his D.M.A. in conducting from the Eastman School of Music, where he studied with Donald Hunsberger. He has a M.M. in Wind Conducting from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois, and a B.A. in Music Education from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa. Former positions held by Dr. Ripley were as Associate Director of Bands at Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, and as a clinical faculty member at Luther College. In addition, Dr. Ripley taught for eleven years in the public schools of Minnesota and Iowa.

Mr. Ripley is an active arranger and editor of wind ensemble music. His performing edition of Howard Hanson's *Triumphal Ode for Military Band* is published by Carl Fischer, and his arrangements for



Dr. John R. Stewart is Professor of Music and Director of Concert Bands at the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire where he conducts the Wind Symphony, teaches courses in conducting and repertoire, supervises student teachers, coordinates the concert band program, and serves as the Wind and Percussion Area Coordinator. Under his leadership, the Wind Symphony performed at the International Tuba Euphonium Conference, the CBDNA/NBA North Central Division Regional Conference, the Minnesota Music Educators Association Mid-Winter Clinic, and his ensembles have performed across Europe and Southeast Asia. Dr. Stewart maintains an active schedule as a guest conductor and clinician across the United States. He completed his Doctor of Philosophy in Music Education (2013) at the University of Minnesota while studying conducting with Craig Kirchhoff. Dr. Stewart earned his Master of Arts in Music Education from the University of South Florida (2009) and a Bachelor of Music Education from the University of Central Florida (1996).

Prior to his appointment at UWEC, Dr. Stewart was Interim Conductor of the St. Cloud State University Wind Ensemble (Minnesota). Dr. Stewart served as Director of Bands at Saint Cloud High School (Florida) from 1996-2010 where he directed the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, Jazz Ensemble, Chamber Winds, Percussion Ensemble and Marching Band. In 2006, he earned his National Board for Professional Teaching Standards and in 2008 was named the St. Cloud High School "Teacher of the Year."

Dr. Stewart contributed to Teaching Music through Performance in Band: Solos with Wind Band Accompaniment published by GIA Publications, Inc., has published articles in Contributions to Music Education, the Minnesota Music Educators Association Journal, the NBA Journal, and presented sessions at the Society for Music Teacher Educators bi-annual conference, the Wisconsin Music Educators Association State Conference, the National Band Association – Wisconsin Chapter State Conference, the MMEA Mid-Winter Clinic, the Florida Music Educators Association Convention, the Colorado Music Educators Association Convention, and the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Wind Ensembles Conference in Prague, CZ.. His current research interests include
