About the Artists

Dave Samuels

Dave Samuels has achieved a sensational career as a jazz vibraphonist and marimba player. His solo work is featured on recent recordings by Gerry Mulligan, Frank Zappa, Spyro Gyra, Chet Baker, and many other artists; most recently he was heard as a featured member of the George Shearing Quintet for a two-week series of concerts with Frank Sinatra at Carnegie Hall. His solo album, One Step Ahead, was released in January; his playing is also featured on the ECM release Double Image and on the soon-to-released Gallery. He is a former member of the Berklee College of Music faculty, and his articles on jazz percussion have been featured in Modern Drummer magazine. Dave's appearance is made possible in part by Ludwig Industries and Schmitt Music Center.

Joe Wilder

Joe Wilder is practically a living legend among jazz trumpet players. A former member of the bands of Les Hite, Jimmy Lunceford, Lionel Hampton, Dizzy Gillespie, and Count Basie, he is regarded as one of the most inventive and tasteful musicians in jazz. As a member of the music staff of ABC for more than 16 years, he performed everything from the solo chair on the Dick Cavett Show Orchestra to the Haydn Trumpet Concerto on a nationwide broadcast. He was a featured soloist with Benny Goodman's famous 1962 Soviet tour, and he has performed with almost every major jazz artist of the past three decades. His most recent solo work can be heard on the Johnny Hartmann album Once In Every Life, which received a 1981 Grammy nomination. We thank the Selmer Company and Schmitt Music Center for helping to make his appearance here possible.
