## INTRODUCTION

FANFARE and ENTRANCE (Read before band starts)

"The Blugold Band is now in its entrance formation and begins our gridiron show with the "Cotton Bowl Fanfare" and "Marching Along Together."

HI-FORMATION (Two parts -- begin when band reaches centerfield)

"The band greets its Eau Claire fans with the traditional Hi formation." (Pause)
"The Hi formation now reverses to greet the visitors from Stevens Point."

TWO-IN-ONE FORMATION (Two parts--letters S and E)

"The band plays a stirring march next and forms the letter S for Stevens Point."

"Now the S is transformed into the letter E for the Blugold fans."

ALMA MATER (E formation-end of march)

"And here is our Alma Mater. Let's all sing it!"

ADE OLSON FORMATION (Read while band is maneuvering into formation)

"To honor Ade Olson, former coach of the Blugolds, the band now spells out 'ADE' and plays and sings 'What's the Matter with Olson' and 'He's a Jolly Good Fellow'."

(Presentation to Ade here)

EXIT (As band leaves field)

"Drum Major Chuck Mehls now leads the Marching Blugolds off the field."
"LET'S GIVE THE BAND A BIG HAND FOR A NICE SHOW."
