UW-Eau Claire Jazz Program

The University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Jazz Ensemble program has a long tradition of outstanding jazz education that has been heralded by international, national, and regional recognition. In 1989 Jazz Ensemble I performed in Europe at the Graz International Music Festival and the internationally acclaimed Montreux Jazz Festival. Last May the group made a historic tour of China becoming the first jazz ensemble to tour the country since opening to the western world ten years ago, and possibly since 1949. Back at home the ensemble has performed at the MENC North Central Division Convention twice in three years and for three Wisconsin Music Educators Conference in the last five years. The ensemble will be releasing its first CD in May.

Their director, Mr. Robert Baca, has toured professionally with The Buddy Rich Band, The Frank Sinatra Orchestra, Tony Bennett, Mel Torme, and The Andy Williams Christmas Tour. He can be heard on weekends as the trumpeter on American Public Radio's "American Radio Company Of The Air" with Garrison Keillor. Mr. Baca performs for the show when it is broadcast from Minneapolis, MN.

The UW-Eau Claire Jazz Area currently maintains five large jazz ensembles (three of which tour nationally and regionally), a vocal jazz ensemble, and eleven combos. It is host to one of the nations largest jazz festivals, now in its 26th year. Dates for this years festival are March 26 and 27. Get reservations early! Many former members of Jazz Ensemble I have become jazz recording artists or pursued professional performing careers throughout the country.

About the Department

The Department of Music at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire is located in the Fine Arts Center on the north bank of the 333-acre campus. It is the largest music school in the state of Wisconsin. The Fine Arts Center includes the 600-seat Gantner Concert Hall, Phillips Recital Hall, recording and electronic music laboratories, studios, offices, classrooms, and music and record libraries.

Over 300 students are music majors and minors at UW-Eau Claire, which has a total student population of nearly 11,000 and a faculty of over 700.

Music minors are offered in elementary general music and liberal arts.
