"The players in the band are enthusiastic boosters of their team. They now present the Blugolds and coach Jim Rice ^{with} a big trophy and play 'Our Boys Will Shine Tonight'."

BLOCK E FORMATION (read during the bells interlude)

"For the returning alumni and the college fans the band now forms its traditional block 'E' and plays our 'Alma Mater'. LET'S ALL SING!"
