ABOUT THE ENSEMBLE

The University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Jazz Ensemble I is the most prestigious and active of four major jazz ensembles. It has won top honors at major jazz festivals throughout the country, and has received acclaim for its performances on tours throughout the Midwest. Past performers in the ensemble have gone on to become members of the bands of Count Basie, Maynard Ferguson, Mel Lewis, Pat Metheny, The O'Jays, and others.

The Ensemble is probably most familiar to the Wisconsin/Minnesota public as the host band for the annual UW-EC Jazz Festival. In this role the Ensemble has accompanied some of the finest soloists in jazz, including Clark Terry, Gary Burton, Snooky Young, Ernie Watts, and many others. This year marks the 20th annual UW-EC Jazz Festival and will be held on March 27 and 28, 1987. This year's featured soloist/clinicians will be trumpeter Dominic Spera and bassist Rufus Reid.



ROBERT BACA, DIRECTOR

Robert Baca is director of jazz ensembles and instructor of trumpet at UW-Eau Claire. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education, a Master's Degree in Trumpet Performance, and is currently completing a Doctorate of Brass Pedagogy from Indiana University. Mr. Baca is a multifaceted performer, teacher, and clinician. He has performed as principal trumpet and soloist with fine orchestras and has toured with many well-known entertainers such as Frank Sinatra, Buddy Rich, Mel Torme, and Tony Bennett. Mr. Baca's duties at UW-EC include teaching jazz improvisation, jazz history, and private trumpet students as well as conducting Jazz Band I and performing with the Faculty Brass Quintet.
