### About the soloists. . .

Rob McConnell - "Band of the Year." Rob McConnell's Boss Brass has yet to reach the plateau of international acceptance it deserves... (with) his own arrangements coupled with the band's impeccable performance level." Leonard Feather. Rob McConnell has swept the jazz world with the stunning sounds of his 22 piece Boss Brass Big Band. McConnell has recorded with a myriad of jazz groups ranging from duets to his Boss Brass. He has toured the world as valve trombone soloist and clinician. He has received many awards for his excellence in jazz; such as the Juno award (3 times) for best jazz album of the year and a Grammy for "All In Good Time." Scholarships have been established in his name and NAJE voted him best arranger. McConnell is a consumate musician, working equally well in both the classical and jazz idioms.

Billy Pierce, graduate of the Berklee College of Music, Boston, remains active as a clinician and guest performance as a faculty member of that school. He has recorded albums with Art Blakey, James Williams, Wynton Marsalis and Gary Burtens as well as many others. His studies have included work with saxophone greats such as Joe Allard, Joe Viola, Andy McGee and Charlie Mariano.

Gene Aitken is presently the Vocal Jazz Chairman of NAJE. He is also the Director of Jazz Studies at the University of Northern Colorado. Aitken has received numerous awards, such as the Jazz Educator of the Year Award from NAJE in 1987, the Excellence in Education award from the Colorado Commission on Higher Education and a Grammy nomination in 1986. He is active as a free-lance bass player and college clinician across the country. Aitken has appeared with Vicki Carr, Mel Torme, Les Elgart and many others. His energetic and captivating work as a clinician and educator has gained his work at UNC much recognition from professional and educational circles.

James Williams has been said to be one of "the exponents of lilting keyboard stylists." Having taught at the Berklee College of Music, boston, and played with Art Blakey and the Jazz Messengers, Williams has earned a vast degree of respect and recognition in the Jazz world. He is recorded on numerous albums with Blakey and as a leader. A graduate of Memphis State University in Music Education, Williams is active as a performer and clinician at colleges and universities; performing with such jazz giants as Clark Terry, Marion McPartland, Art Farmer, James Moody and Milt Jackson.
