Dr. Todd Fiegel, a native of Elkhorn, Wisconsin, is serving in his first year as Director of University Bands at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire, succeeding Dr. Donald S. George in that position. He was previously on the Faculties of the University of Montana and Idaho State University and served as Artist-in-Residence Conductor at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. He holds a doctorate in conducting from the University of Colorado, where he studied with Allan McMurray; his other degrees are from the University of Wisconsin, where he worked with H. Robert Reynolds. Dr. Fiegel is active as a clinician and guest conductor in both the United States and Canada, in which country he has conducted from westernmost Vancouver Island to the eastern coast of Newfoundland. Fiegel is also a serious devotee of film music, lecturing frequently on the subject and preparing articles for publication. He has conducted his own silent-film score Celluloid Tubas in well over a hundred performances coast to coast, and his thorough examination of Bernard Herrmann's landmark score for The Day the Earth Stood Still will appear in the premiere issue of The Journal of Film Music this spring.
